Chardonnay La Misión is a single vineyard wine hailing from the Alto Maipo Valley in the foothills of the Andes. The vineyard -Punta Almendro- is located at almost 1,000 meters above sea level. The clone was imported direct from William Fèvre Burgundy when the joint venture began twenty years ago. The vineyard yield is 1.9 kg. per plant or 7,500 kg/ha.

### Winemaking note

Once the grapes from the Chardonnay vines are harvested, they are pressed using a controlled method. This process involves pressing the grapes very gently. The juices are fermented in stainless steel tanks for ten to fifteen days at 16 to 18°C. Some lees are present in the tanks, but there is little battonage type work stirring the lees in this wine.

### Tasting note

The nose is fruity with notes of pineapple, pears and maracuya. In the mouth it has a nice medium body with complexity in refreshing fruits. It is a very expressive wine, which represents a fine height Chardonnay.
